

Uniform Exchange

Desert View Academy will be offering a Uniform Exchange starting on October 1. This exchange is for all students and their families as a way to assist each other in meeting the uniform requirements here at DVA.

Here's how it works:

1. You can bring in any uniform items and exchange them for another size as your child grows. When you bring items in, you will be given a credit for each item and those credits can be used right then, or at a later time. When you need some uniform items, you can come browse through the current supply of shirts/bottoms and take what you need based on the amount of credits you have stored up.
2. Items must be in good condition. Items with holes, stains, or excessively worn or faded items will not be accepted.
3. Polo shirts must be dark green, burgundy/maroon, or white and have a DVA logo. DVA "character counts" t-shirt with the eagle in green or white will be accepted as well.
4. Pants, shorts, skorts, skirts, and jumpers will be accepted, also in good condition. Items must meet current uniform requirements.
5. Hooded zip-up jackets with DVA logo will be accepted.

The Exchange will be made at the home of Jennifer Freedman at 1254 S. 41st Drive in Yuma, located just west of Avenue C, off of 12th Place.
